



## SAVE NASHVILLE NOW SUSPENDS CAMPAIGN

(Nashville) – [Save Nashville Now](#) announced today the campaign is suspending operations, effective June 30th, after yesterday’s ruling from Chancery Court.

Chancery Court Judge Russell Perkins ruled the 4GoodGovernment referendum was unconstitutional.

He ordered the July 27th election cancelled.

If Chancellor Perkin’s ruling is appealed and there is a change in the status of the campaign, Save Nashville Now will be prepared to restart our efforts to explain to Nashville voters how this referendum will hurt Nashville’s future and severely cut Metro budgets, adversely affecting families, teachers, students, first responders and emergency responders citywide.

The Save Nashville Now coalition joined together faith leaders from more than 50 churches, city business leaders and nearly two dozen community organizations to defeat the referendum.
